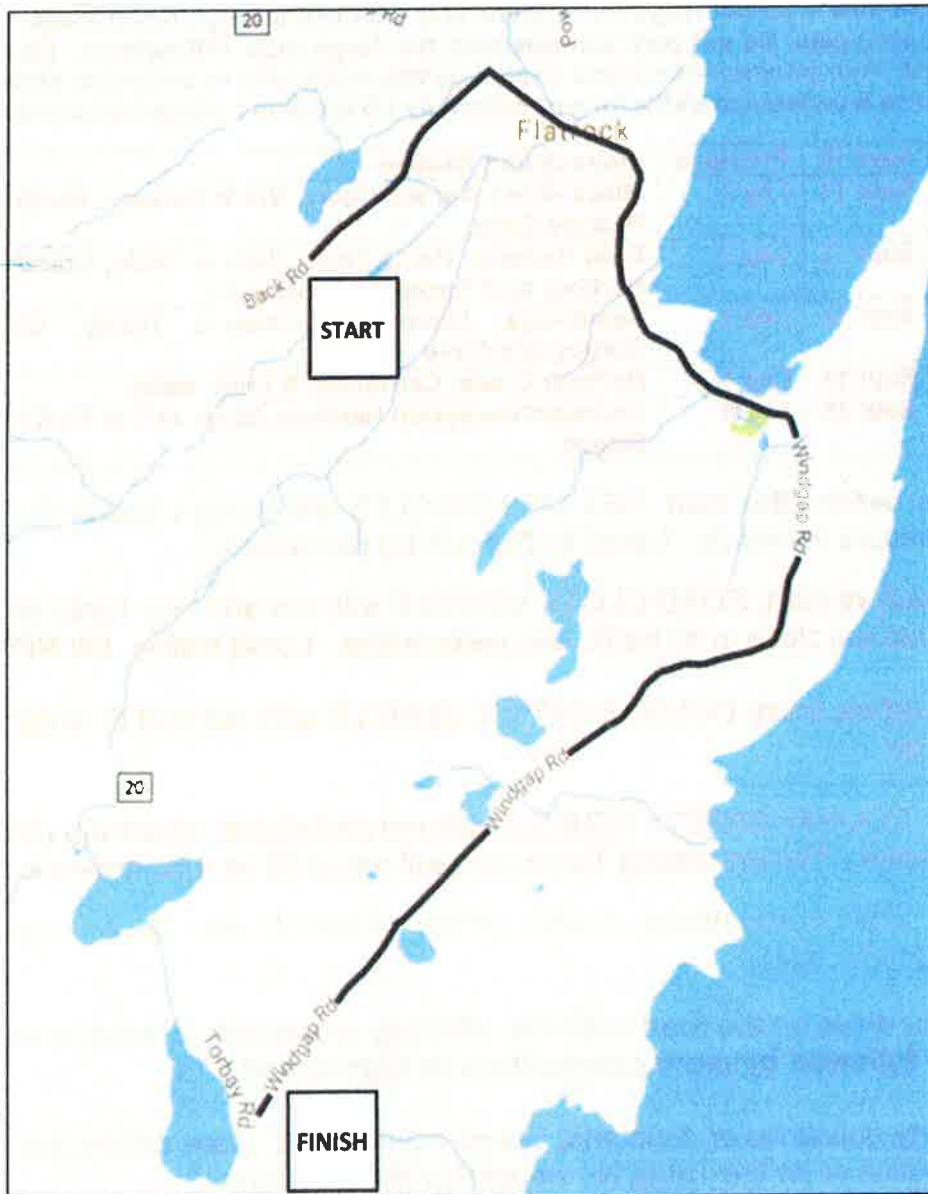

# TARGA NEWFOUNDLAND IS COMING TO YOUR AREA



## Enjoy the Event Safely Do Not Stand Behind Red Tape.

The first priority of Targa officials and volunteers is ensuring the safety of everyone along the route. Obey Safety Marshals in yellow Targa vests. Stand only behind the yellow taped areas. Supervise children closely and control pets. Do not park vehicles near the Targa route (15 meters). Do not cross the road during the event. With the assistance of your community volunteers, officials and police, sections of road will be closed to vehicles & pedestrian traffic for approximately 1.5 hours to facilitate the running of Targa NL stages.

Monday	Sept 11	Leg 1	Black River, Garden Cover, North Harbour, North West Brook to Hodges Cove.
Tuesday	Sept 12	Leg 2	Boat Harbour, Petite Forte, Harbour Mille, Grand Le Pierre, English Harbour and Terrenceville Branch.
Wednesday	Sept 13	Leg 3	Lethbridge, Brooklyn, Lockston, Trouty, George's Brook & Burgoyne's Cove
Thursday	Sept 14	Leg 4	Harbour Grace, Carbonear & Freshwater
Friday	Sept 15	Leg 5	Colliers/Conception Harbour, Marysvale to Turk's Gut, Makinsons & Brigus

**120 minutes before the start**, SET-UP VEHICLES will move through the stage assisting marshals to secure the stage. **Local traffic will be permitted.**

**30 minutes before start**, ROAD CLOSE VEHICLE with red and blue lights and siren will enter the stage. Road will close to all traffic and pedestrians. **Local traffic will NOT be permitted.**

**10 minutes before start**, COURSE CHECK VEHICLE with red and blue lights will enter and check the stage.

**At start time**, COURSE SAFETY VEHICLE with red and blue lights will do a final check and act as first competitor. The competing Targa cars will run at 30 second intervals for one hour.

**Immediately after competition**, ROAD OPEN VEHICLE with Green Lights Flashing will officially reopen the road.

**Do not walk or drive on the road until it is officially reopened. Breaks in competitor traffic are possible followed by more competitors at high speed.**
