2018 Summer Program Information**

1. What is Flatrock Summer Camp?

Our Summer Camp is an affordable and very enjoyable camp for children ages 6 to 12 (within the calendar year). The camp is full of fun activities and outings that your children will love!

2. What are the dates and Themes for the Summer Program?

3. What is included in our Summer Camp?

Flatrock Recreation is pleased to offer a camp that offers a variety of activities and events for all to enjoy. Here is a breakdown of what to expect during your summer camp experience.

- A minimal of two off site outings a week.
- A number of special visitors to camp.
- Special camp theme days (eg. Newfoundland Day)
- Free snacks/lunches on certain days.

4. What is the location of the Summer Camp?

Our Summer Camp is located at the Red Head Road Recreational Complex. On poor weather days, camp will be held at the Flatrock Community Centre or Cape St. Francis Elementary. Parents and Guardians will be notified via email and radio announcements regarding the location of camp should we have to move to our inside location.

5. What are the Hours of Operation?

Our Summer Camp runs Monday to Friday, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. We encourage parents and guardians to drop off their children by 9:30 am.

6. How much does Summer Camp Cost?

Flatrock Recreation strives to provide a very affordable summer camp. Our current rate is \$95 per child per week. Additional children are just \$65 extra per week. We also charge a \$7 (per camper) t-shirt fee.

7. When is registration?

Registration will be held on Monday, May 14th, from 7:00 – 8:00 pm, for residents of Flatrock, 8:00 – 8:30 pm for tax payers of Flatrock (individuals who reside outside of Flatrock but pay taxes in the community and grandparents who live in the community) and Wednesday, May 16th, from 7:00 – 8:00 pm for non-residents. Please note that you may be required to provide proof of address. Registration will occur at the Flatrock Town Hall. Registration fees and camp T-shirt fee are payable in full on registration night.

8. What will I need for registration?

In an attempt to speed up the registration process, all required documents will be posted on www.townofflatrock.com before registration. We strongly encourage residents to complete these forms and bring them to registration.

9. What is the method of payment?

Registration fees can be in the form of cash, cheque, debit and credit cards. Please be advised that cash and debit payments are due in full on the night of registration. Pre – authorized payment plans will be available for individuals who wish to pay with postdated cheques or credit cards. There will be a separate form that needs to be completed at registration for this.

10. How much food should I pack in my child's bag for lunch?

Every day the camp will stop all activities for a morning snack, lunch, and an afternoon snack. Please pack enough food and drinks for each of these times. With all the activities that we do, please pack enough water for your child so they can drink throughout the day. Please do not pack any type of nuts (tree nuts or peanuts) fish, or eggs as we must provide a safe and allergy free environment for all children in the camp.

11. What should my child bring for the day?

Lots of food and water will be needed as your child will be active all day. The summer sun can be very dangerous, so we ask children to bring their own sunscreen each week of camp. Of course, extra clothes always come in handy if something was to rip or become dirty while playing outside. Don't forget a jacket as the temperature can change very quickly each day. **Electronic devices are NOT permitted.**
